## 2017 Landfill & Yard Waste Pickup Schedule

**Note: Items must be curbside no later than 8:00 am the day of pickup.** After a street has been picked up the DPW will not return to pick up items that are put out after they've been through.

**Landfill:** includes old furniture, rugs, linoleum and open and dried paint cans. **NO METAL!** **The following will not be picked up:** tires, household chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, etc., construction debris, paint cans that are not open, computers, monitors, or televisions.

*No metal with landfill items.*

Rate schedule: 1st bucket \$0; 2nd bucket \$10; additional buckets \$20 (bucket refers to full backhoe bucket).

August 10  
September 14  
October 12

**Yard Waste:** includes leaves, branches, garden plants and brush (cut 4' length). Uncut branches and brush will **NOT** be picked up.

June 22  
July 27

October 26

**Metal:** includes refrigerators, air conditioners, water heaters, lawn mowers, and scrap metal. No paint cans (put those out on landfill day).

### Yard Waste Pickup:

The DPW requests that residents not place yard waste on tarps or in plastic bags. Use of garbage cans is acceptable. If you have any questions, please call the DPW at 684-3776



# EATON ST/WEST MAPLE AVE WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



Syracuse Constructors, LLC will soon be installing 2,300 feet of 6-inch water main on Eaton Street and West Maple Avenue. The old pipe dates back to the early 1950s and needs to be replaced. Work is scheduled to begin on June 21 and is expected to conclude by the end of August.

In addition to the water project, Madison County Highway Department will also replace a box culvert under Eaton Street, and will reconstruct all of Eaton Street from Route 20 to the village line. New storm sewer systems will be installed on West Maple Avenue and Eaton Street, along with the installation of concrete curbing along a portion of Eaton Street. Madison County Highway Department will begin work July 3 with the intention of completing toward the end of August, weather permitting. **The County project will result in Eaton Street being closed for 6 to 8 weeks**, but all property owners will have daily access to their driveways. Madison County will implement a local traffic detour using Union Street and East Maple Avenue and a truck detour to South Street.

**ROAD

We realize this project will be an inconvenience, but replacing aging water mains and repairing roads will improve the community for years to come by providing safe roads and reliable water service to residents in the area.

### *Thinking About Becoming a Landlord?*

To rent any property or part of it as a residence or dwelling, the owner must first obtain a certificate of compliance issued by the Code Enforcement Officer of the Village of Morrisville. Compliance with the requirements of Chapter 143 (Rental Property) and Chapter 180 (Zoning) of the Code of the Village of Morrisville is required. Failure to comply with any provision of these chapters is punishable by a fine.

For more information regarding Village Code, contact the Village Office and ask to speak with the Code Enforcement Officer.



### **Village Taxes will be collected until June 30 without penalty.**

After June 30, a fee of five per centum will be charged and an additional one per centum per month thereafter.
